Directions to Camp Peniel:

From 219 North to Salisbury:

From Interstate 68 take Exit 22. (Meyersdale/219 North). On 219 N travel approx. 4 miles to Salisbury, PA. Turn right at the first light and head toward Pocahontas. At the top of the hill, turn right onto Greenville Rd. Travel approx. 4 miles to a Y in the road. Bear left at the Y. At the second Y, Greenville Rd bears to the left. Stay on Greenville Rd. Soon you will see a sign for Camp Peniel. Turn left at the sign onto Mountain Rd. If you pass the Greenville Lutheran church on Greenville Rd, you've gone too far. At the bottom of a long hill on Mountain Rd, turn left into Camp Peniel. Follow the gravel lane approximately one half mile to the buildings.

From 68 West from Cumberland:

Travel west on Interstate 68 to Finzel (Exit #29). Bear to the right to travel north towards Pennsylvania. Continue traveling straight through Finzel (very small town), Maryland. After crossing into Pennsylvania, continue traveling straight through Pocahontas (very, very small town). In approximately 3 miles, a sign for Camp Albrioca will be on the left. Shortly past the sign is a little brick church (Greenville Lutheran) on the right. Immediately following the church, turn right onto a gravel road. At the bottom of a long hill, turn left into Camp Peniel. Follow the gravel lane approximately one half of a mile to the buildings.
