

Advanced Degrees in Ministry Scholarship Fund Information

Purpose: To promote the development of Ministers of the Gospel.

Goals: To provide financial assistance to those seeking an advanced degree in

ministry.

Guidelines:

• Preference is given for candidates seeking degrees of Masters in Divinity, Apologetics, or Counseling.

- Candidate is a member in good standing of Cherry Glade Mennonite Church for at least one year at time of application.
- Candidate has a desire to serve at Cherry Glade or a CMC Congregation on completion of seminary.
- Candidate demonstrates leadership ability by mentoring, encouraging, and leading other members of Cherry Glade.
- The maximum amount available is 2/3 of the cost of tuition. Individual amounts will be determined on a case by case basis based on the funding available.
- Exceptions to guidelines may be granted with approval of the Pastoral Team and FAPC.

Procedure:

- Candidate completes application.
- Candidate is interviewed by Pastoral Team.
- Discernment process involving the candidate's calling and training selection with the Pastoral Team.
- Approval by Lead Pastor and Pastoral Team.
- Cost evaluation approval by Finance & Property Commission.
- Candidate submits invoices to Treasurer for payment or reimbursement.
- Treasurer disburses funds.

Evaluation:

- Applicant must maintain a minimum GPA of 2.5 in order to receive future awards unless exception is granted by the Pastoral Team and the FAPC.
- Ministry Scholarship Fund to be evaluated periodically by Pastoral Team and FAPC.
